Choose high-quality fixtures for plumbing, lighting, appliances, and hardware to enhance functionality, aesthetics, and durability while minimizing	
Avoid cutting corners on critical components such as structural integrity, insulation, roofing, and safety features. Be flexible with budgets by prioritizing essential aspects while exploring cost-effective alternatives for non-essential elements.
